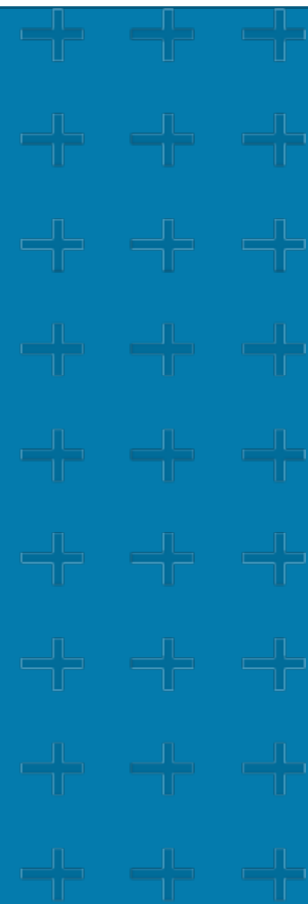

We must recover our family identity and personal value.



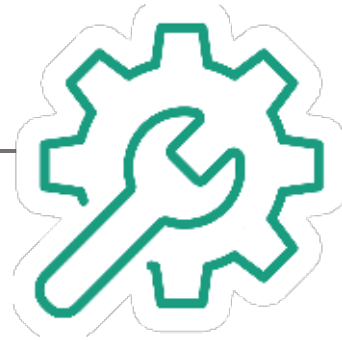

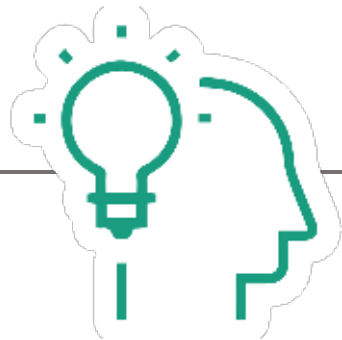
